**PRAYER**

Immediately upon being introduced into a lodge of Masons, we are admonished: "My friend, no man should ever enter upon any great or important undertaking without first invoking the blessing of Deity." Lodge meetings are opened and closed with prayers, and prayer has an important place in other parts of the ritual. This leads critics to raise a great hue and cry as to whether Masonry is a religion, what relation if any it has to the church, etc. Without going into this subject very deeply, might we remind our readers that the Entered Apprentice advises us that he has come to "learn, to subdue my passions, and improve myself in Masonry." Webb's Monitor states: "Masonry is a system, teaching symbolically piety, morality, science, charity, and self-discipline."

One of the finest statements regarding prayer that we have ever read occurs in *Morals and Dogma*, written by the great Albert Pike: "Though Masonry neither usurps the place of, nor apes religion, prayer is an essential part of our ceremonies. It is the aspiration of the soul toward the Absolute and Infinite Intelligence which is the One Supreme Deity, most feebly and misunderstandingly characterized as an 'Architect.' Certain faculties of man are directed toward the Unknown – thought, meditation, prayer. The unknown is an ocean, of which conscience is the compass. Thought, meditation, prayer, are the great mysterious pointings of the needle. It is a spiritual magnetism that thus connects the human soul with the Deity. These majestic irradiations of the soul pierce through the shadow toward the light...Prayer is sublime. Orisons that beg and clamor are pitiful. To deny the efficacy of prayer is to deny that of Faith, Love, and Effort. Yet the effects produced when our hand, moved by our will; launches a pebble into the ocean, never cease; and every uttered word is registered for eternity upon the invisible air."

**First Degree Tracing Board by Josiah Bowring, 1819.** Tracing Boards are teaching aids used in explaining the meaning of the various symbols encountered in a particular degree. They were originally designed to lay flat on the ground so that the brothers may gather around and observe. They have a strong tradition in English and Canadian masonic ritual.
